12. Brief Report:



An expert talk and live demonstration was organized at Nirwan University Jaipur in collaboration with Artisan Agro India Pvt. Ltd. In this program, Managing Director of Artisan Agro India Pvt. Ltd. Ramprasad Joshi and bamboo plant expert Dayaram Khagi interacted with the students as experts. During this, 1000 bamboo plants were planted with the help of Artisan Agro India Pvt. Ltd. which annually produces 70,000 tons of oxygen and 200,000 tons of oxygen. It will provide tonnes of biomass and will also prove to be helpful in saving the environment. In this program, expert Ram Prasad Joshi said that bamboo plant can help a lot in the economic strength of the country. Now in India, farmers can increase their income and connect the youth with the business of bamboo plant. This is being done so that along with increasing the income of more and more farmers, the youth of the country can get employment opportunities. In view of these possibilities, National Bamboo Mission has been formed on 25-04-2018 by amending the Indian Forest Act. On this occasion, Chairman of Nirvana University, Dr. S.L. Sihag said that biotechnology will increase the possibilities of economic transformation and employment in the country. CEO and Vice Chairman Dr. R.K. Arora said that the ambitious National Bamboo Mission of the Government of India. This workshop has been organized under the project. According to Vice Chancellor Prof. Arvind Kumar Aggarwal, bamboo industry can provide employment to lakhs of people in rural areas and will also prove helpful in environmental protection. 


