Nirwan University Jaipur has organized a five-day FDP program on anti-ragging entitled "Ragging: Prevention, Prohibition, and Punishment (3Ps)" from 12th August to 18th August 2023. As per instructions from the UGC, Anti Ragging Day will be observed on 12th August, followed by Anti Ragging Week from 12th August to 18th August 2023 in educational institutions. The main aim of the lectures and documentaries on Anti-ragging is to educate and create awareness among the students and faculty members about the ill effects of ragging. "Ragging: Prevention, Prohibition, and Punishment" refers to a comprehensive approach to addressing the issue of ragging in educational institutions. It involves a combination of strategies aimed at preventing the occurrence of ragging, prohibiting such behavior through strict policies and regulations, and imposing appropriate punishments on those found guilty of engaging in ragging activities. This approach is designed to create a safe and conducive learning environment for the students to eliminate the harmful effects of ragging. FDP programme was attended by 15 faculties and around 30 students.

FIRST DAY (12-08-2023)

Prof. N.D. Jasuja, Joint Registrar, Nirwan University, delivered a lecture on "PREVENTION AND PROHIBITION OF RAGGING". The Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging aims to create a safe and inclusive environment within educational institutions by eradicating the practice of ragging. Ragging refers to any form of physical, verbal, or psychological abuse or harassment that is inflicted on newcomers or junior students by senior students.

SECOND DAY (14-08-2023)

Prof. Preeti Sharma, Dean of Sciences, delivered a lecture on "WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING?" This talk delivers the deeper aspects of ragging, including its history, types, consequences, and efforts to prevent and eliminate it.

THIRD DAY (16-08-2023)

Dr. K.C. Saini, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, delivered a lecture on "LEGAL PERSPECTIVES OF RAGGING". The aim of studying the legal perspectives of ragging is to understand the legal framework and regulations surrounding the issue of ragging, as well as the implications and consequences of engaging in or facilitating such activities.


FOURTH DAY (17-08-2023)




